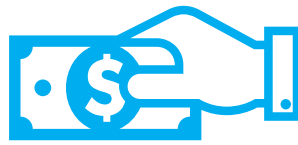


Response of faculty, coaches, staff, and administrators, to the COVID-19 challenge. The courage, creativity, and determination was admirable
