
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Imagine a train track stretching out before you. It's a simple illustration, but it's incredibly powerful - because it represents everything you need to be an effective ministry leader. TrainingTracks uses this method to help aspiring ministry leaders get on the right track. Just like a train needs all three parts of the track to move forward, you need all three key components to succeed in ministry: Knowing, Doing, Being. We believe that anyone can become an effective leader when they have the right tools and mindset.



### HOW DOES IT WORK?

First, each intern will be paired with a Ministry Mentor that comes alongside each intern for direction, debriefing, and encouragement. Each Ministry Mentor will be given the training information (digitally) that guides them through the internship and should be meeting at least once a week if not more. This Ministry Mentor is also the main contact with the Leadership Pipeline.

Second, each week the interns will watch 1-2 short training videos (most are 10 mins or less) and then join all other interns nationwide on (something like zoom) once a week for a cohort that includes discussion on that week's topic, prayer, and encouragement.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### May Ministry Mentors (or new pastors) join?

Yes. Ministry Mentors are always welcome to join in on the training. And you may even join in on the discussion as well!

#### What are the requirements or expectations of the training?

To qualify for scholarships, benefits, and continued involvement with the Pipeline this training is required for all interns.

## What about if my internship is longer or shorter timeframe or if we have to miss a week?

Our intention is to make the training and customizable as possible. If you can join us when you can and then watch the training videos when you can't that is ideal. An intern can always meet with their ministry mentor for discussion.

What if the zoom cohort time does not work for my ministry? Since this is a nationwide program we try our best to accommodate as many people as possible. We will work with you as best we can, if there is enough interns we might have two cohort times.

### How many weeks is the training?

There are eight weeks of training with extra supplemental video if you desire more training.

## What if my internship is outside of summer? Does this work for a school year residency?

Right now the training can be used outside the summer months, but we are redesigning it for a 9 month residency.
